

TAKEOVER

New York Broker

Shareholders are advised that Green Machine Development Corporation (the Company) has no knowledge of, nor association with, a New York based broking house claiming to represent a party, or parties, making a takeover bid for your Company. A number of shareholders have contacted the Company advising that they have been approached.

Your board believes the renewed interest in the Company may be as a result of the discovery of gold deposits in the Murray Basin in Australia. As announced on 21st July 2009 the Company is in negotiations to acquire a strategic interest in New World Petroleum (NSW) Limited (hereafter referred to as NWP). NWP has interests in two leases covering 11,000 square kilometres in the Murray Basin of New South Wales.

Murray Basin

The Murray Basin covers an area of over one million square kilometres (409,835 sq mi) containing the Murray River. The Murray River forms the boarder between the Australian states of New South Wales and Victoria also running into the state of South Australia. This prospect is for petroleum, coal, coal bed methane gas, and water. The Company's initial interest was for these resources however the recent announcement by GeoScience Victoria of the discovery of a world-class gold resource in the Murray Basin region of the state of Victoria has sparked an interest in the prospect of gold on these leases.

To reiterate, our announcement on 29th August 2009 quoting the following interviews. Speaking on the Australian Broadcasting Corporation's PM programme on 17th August 09, resource manager at GeoScience Victoria, Paul McDonald, said there could be enough gold in the new field to double the state's historical output.

We've found that there's over 70 million ounces of gold. The amount of gold produced in Victoria over the last 150 years is about 80 million ounces, and that's found in rock sort of poking out of the ground. We've identified the same set of rocks heading north, what we call undercover of some Murray Basin sediments and the same rocks exist, so the potential for the same amount of gold exists in those rocks. In today's pricing, gold is around about (Aud)\$1,150 an ounce, so times that by 70 million and I think it would be up around sort of \$80 billion or so.

Gold and Carbon Credits

Your board holds great hopes for the possibility of gold on the NWP leases. This in now way diminishes the attraction of coal bed methane, which is likely to attract "Carbon Credits" upon production opening a further income source for the Company.

Warning

Your board understands that some shareholders circumstances may have change since investing in the Company and may wish to avail themselves of offers made to them from time to time. If you decide to sell your shares then it is most important that you ***do not send any money*** to the acquiring party in advance of the sale. Listing

The timing of the listing is subject to change and has yet to be determined. The board's intention is to list as soon as practicable but at a time, which will return maximum benefits to the majority of shareholders. We understand that this delay will inconvenience a small number of shareholders. The board is however charged with the responsibility of acting in the best interests of the Company and the members as a whole.
